## What is M-Step?

New learning standards require new ways to measure how much students know and can do. That's why in 2014-15, Michigan replaced the 44 year old MEAP test with the new Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP).

McDonald Elementary students will be taking the M-STEP online. M-STEP is aligned to Michigan's challenging learning standards and is administered each Spring in the subjects and grade levels listed under "Test Dates & Subjects by

Grade Level" in the left-hand column.

M-STEP has fewer multiple choice questions and more questions that require problems solving and critical thinking skills than the previous MEAP assessment.
